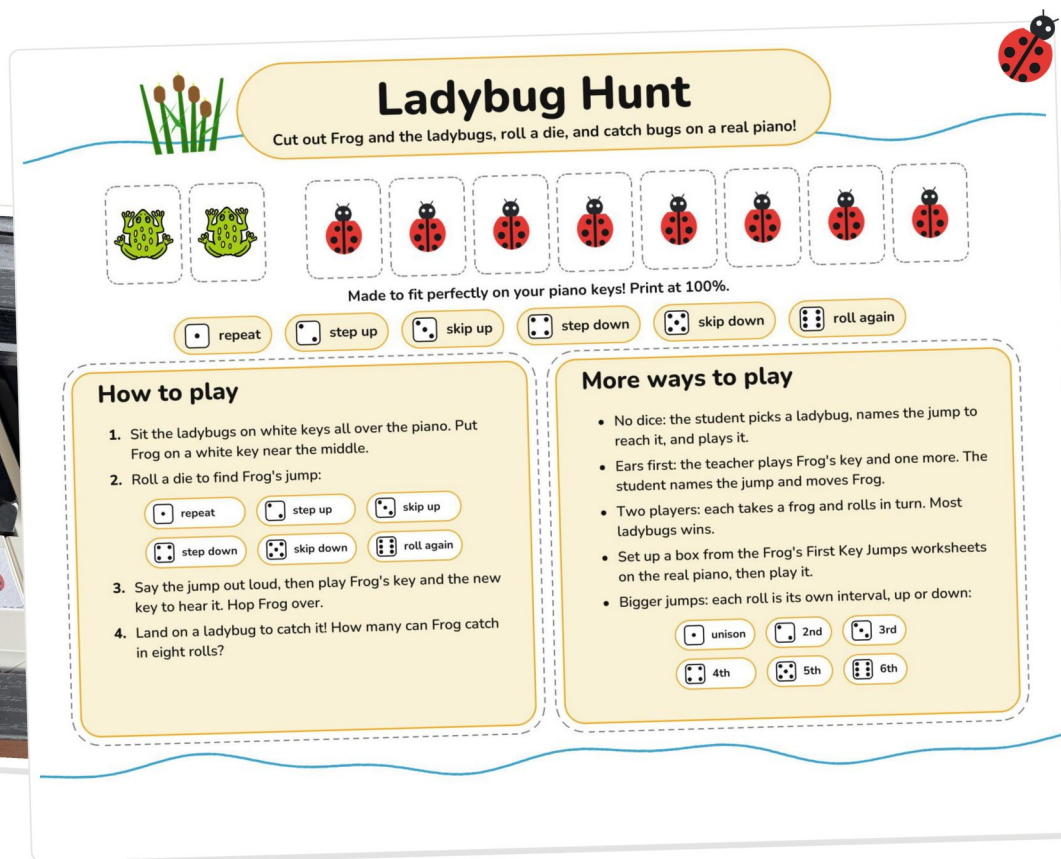


Ladybug Hunt

Frog, eight ladybugs, a dice key, and two panels of ways to play. Print at 100% on card stock.

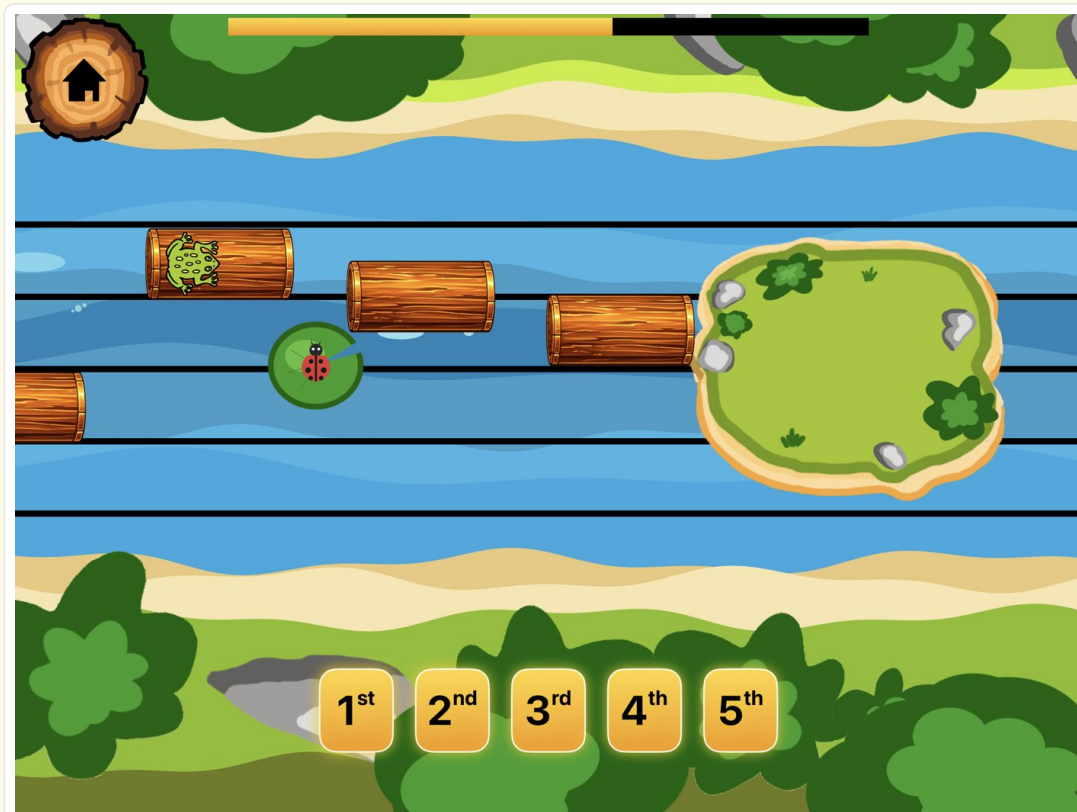


Keep learning with Interval Jump

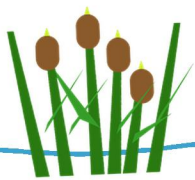

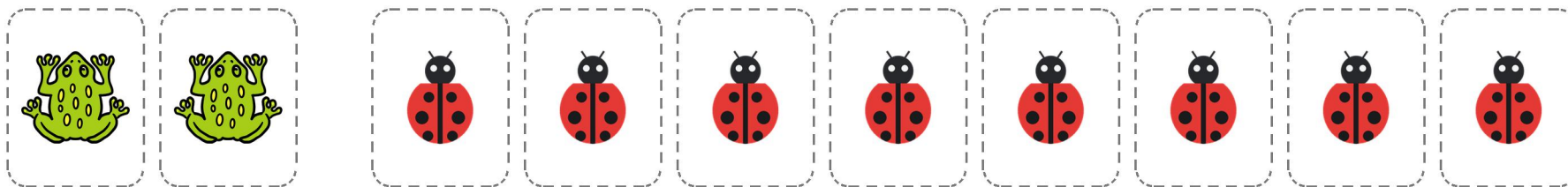
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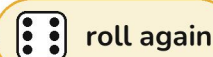


Ladybug Hunt

Cut out Frog and the ladybugs, roll a die, and catch bugs on a real piano!



Made to fit perfectly on your piano keys! Print at 100%.



How to play

1. Sit the ladybugs on white keys all over the piano. Put Frog on a white key near the middle.
2. Roll a die to find Frog's jump:
3. Say the jump out loud, then play Frog's key and the new key to hear it. Hop Frog over.
4. Land on a ladybug to catch it! How many can Frog catch in eight rolls?

More ways to play

- No dice: the student picks a ladybug, names the jump to reach it, and plays it.
- Ears first: the teacher plays Frog's key and one more. The student names the jump and moves Frog.
- Two players: each takes a frog and rolls in turn. Most ladybugs wins.
- Set up a box from the Frog's First Key Jumps worksheets on the real piano, then play it.
- Bigger jumps: each roll is its own interval, up or down:
